West Hill Primary School PTFA is excited to announce a new way of fundraising which is being launched today. Rocket Fund is a Crowdfunding platform for schools designed to reduce educational inequality by modernising school funding.

Back in February we agreed to fund the purchase of 32 Chrome books with a storage trolley to keep them safe and to enable them to move between classrooms. Unfortunately due to COVID-19 this has been put on hold along with our summer term fundraising plans. We were unable to have two of our biggest fundraisers-the Summer Fete and very popular Winter Ball which both normally bring in a substantial amount of money.

The school are still very much in need of the Chrome books, so we have agreed to continue to purchase these, but we really need your support. We are currently at one of our lowest balances ever, with regular subscriptions and other requests from school unlikely to be met.

We do understand that fundraising in the current climate is difficult and that after the year 2020 has brought some of you, donating could be challenging and not an option for some of you. We are also aware that other parents have discussed wanting to donate the money they would have spent at the summer fete/winter ball but were unable to.
