

Terms of Reference for the Curriculum Lead

The Governing Board's responsibilities for teaching and learning:

The Governing Board has general responsibility for the conduct of the school with a view to promoting high standards of educational achievement (Guide to the Law for School Governors). Every child matters and the Governing Board will want to ensure that in all its activities the school is enabling every child or young person to achieve his or her full potential and maximise his or her life chances, choices and opportunities.

Best Value

- Consult - involving stakeholders, especially pupils and parents;
